


Day 1: Middle, McQueen Lake, Kamloops

**Event location:** From Kamloops, drive west from Downtown following the direction signs across the South Thompson River to North Kamloops and the Airport. At the junction with 8th Avenue, turn North following the signs to Westsyde. After 1km there is a major junction. Keep North to Batchelor Drive which becomes Lac Du Bois Road. Follow the road to the major junction at 16km. The route will be marked from there. Parking is by the road. The McQueen Centre is 1km on the road to the east.
