

Sage O Club Report for 2018

We have had a successful year in many respects:

- Our membership has declined from last year, with a big drop in Kamloops. Kelowna numbers are up as a result of the OART. Event participation and the number of events were high, but both values were inflated by the OART with 7 events in 2 days.
